York Surf Club Member Board Locker Agreement

June 16, 2025

- 1. Subject to approval by a York Surf Club (YSC) Advisor, a YSC member will be assigned to a locker that contains YSC owned and shared boards.
- 2. Subject to approval by a YSC Advisor and availability, a YSC member will be assigned to a board locker for storage of that member's private board.
- 3. Approval of access to either type of board locker is contingent upon a YSC member passing a surf skills test.
- 4. To continue the use of a board storage locker the YSC member must text either; a. the YSC group text string, or b. a YSC Advisor of their intention of using their assigned board locker(s). This will allow tracking how often a YSC member uses their locker. Failure to provide text notification of locker use will result in access to a board locker being revoked. Minimal use of a board locker, as defined by a YSC Advisor, may result in the loss of that member's assignment to a board locker(s).
- 5. Locker assignments will be shared with other YSC members.
- 6. Lockers numbered 1 through 3 will be for YSC owned and shared boards.
- 7. Lockers numbered 4 through 6 will be for YSC member owned boards.
- 8. Each locker can store up to three boards with a limit of one board per YSC member assigned to that locker.
- 9. Lockers will be secured only with YSC owned combination locks.
- 10. Upon 48 hours' notice, a YSC member using a board locker for private board storage must remove their board (and any other items) stored in their locker. Failure to do so may result in the Yorks Park and Recreation Department removing that member's board and storing it for up to one week. After that period, the failure of the member to pick up their board or (any other item) stored in the locker, may result in these items becoming the property of the YSC and available for shared use.
- 11. YSC members can share boards from their assigned shared board locker with guests provided that; a. they confirm via text that other members sharing that locker do not need one of the shared boards, and b. the guest uses their board only when lifeguards are on duty or the parent of the YSC member or guest is present on the beach to monitor the guest in the water.
- 12. YSC members who receive board locker assignments agree to treat with great care all boards stored in the locker they access.
- 13. YSC takes no responsibility for damage or loss of private boards stored in the YSC provided lockers.
- 14. This YSC Member Board Locker Agreement is subject to change at any time. The most current version will be posted on the YSC webpage of the Yorks Park and Recreation website.
