Teen Songwriting Workshop **NEW**

Ages 12-18

The Teen Songwriters in the Round is for students ages 12-18 to workshop their original song ideas in a supportive setting. Students will perform their own songs during class and learn how to provide constructive feedback to other students in the group. This is a peer-led group with a York Parks and Recreation faculty advisor. Students will learn how to take their song ideas and develop them into performance ready pieces. The workshop is a collaboration with York Parks and Recreation, the non profit Inspired Nation and their annual event New England Sings.

* New England Sings (NES) is a benefit youth vocal competition and performance. The event highlights aspiring singers from the New England area between the ages of 12 - 21 while putting a spotlight on the area's youth in need. NES is sponsored by Inspired Nation, a non-profit that aims to provide a platform for youth vocal artists and in the process, raise money for charitable organizations focused on youth. Co-founded by former American Idol Judge and fellow community member Kara DioGuardi, Inspired Nation's mission is to empower youth to use their voices as tools for change. NES hinges on the idea that young people have talent and wisdom to contribute to our community, and if we give them a platform, they can use their voices not only to share their stories but also to advocate for young people who are facing challenges by raising money and awareness.

***Inspired Nation will be holding the fourth annual New England Sings Competition on Tuesday October 15th at the Ogunquit Playhouse.


