

2021 REC BY THE RIVER PROTOCOLS

Thank you for choosing to spend your summer with us. While strides have been made in the past year since we were all introduced to COVID-19, our plans for operation this summer include taking steps to protect all those at camp that are not yet eligible for vaccination or are unvaccinated. We plan to spend as much time outdoors as possible. **Please review the protocols below, sign, keep a copy with you and give the other signed copy to staff when you arrive on the first day.**

CAMP LOCATION

Goodrich Park/Grant House – 200 US-1

CAMPER DROP-OFF/PICK-UP

All campers should be dropped off and picked up by the barn. Please enter Goodrich Park/Grant House parking lot via Ferry Ln ONLY and pull up to the drop-off/pick-up area.

- **Drop-Off** runs from **8:50am-9:00am**
- **Pick-Up** runs from **11:20am-11:30am**

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP ROUTINE

Parent/guardian and camper must wait in their vehicle until a staff member greets them. Once a staff member greets them the parent/guardian may get out of their vehicle to help their child. Staff will ask the parent/guardian to initial next to their child's name after a verbal health screening (see health screening question below) with the camper has been completed. Please drive slowly when entering and exiting the parking lot.

HEALTH SCREENING QUESTION

Have you or anyone in your household had any of the following symptoms in the last 7 days: sore throat, cough, chills, body aches, shortness of breath, loss of smell, loss of taste, fever greater than 100 degrees?

MASK USE

When engaged in outdoor camp activities campers and staff will **NOT** be required to wear a mask. Campers and staff **WILL BE REQUIRED** to wear a mask inside the barn.

Families will need to supply at least 2 clean cloth masks for their child to allow for replacing the covering as needed. Masks should be cleaned daily and clearly labeled.

HAND HYGIENE

Campers and staff will be instructed in proper hand washing techniques and will be required to wash their hands regularly throughout the morning. We will also be using liquid hand sanitizer

during times that hand washing is not available or easily accessible. Handwashing/sanitizing will occur:

- Upon entry into and exit from program space
- After sneezing, coughing or nose blowing
- After using the restroom
- After using any shared equipment
- After contact with facemask

RESPONDING TO ILLNESS

The following new symptoms, if observed in a child are cause for immediate isolation and exclusion from camp:

- Fever (100.0° and higher)
- Chills
- Achy
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Difficulty breathing
- Gastrointestinal distress (nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea)
- Loss of taste or smell

The following symptoms, if observed in combination with symptoms above, are cause for immediate isolation and exclusion from camp:

- Fatigue
- Headache
- Runny nose or congestion (not due to other known causes, such as allergies)
- Any other signs of illness

Camp will have a designated isolation area for an individual exhibiting any of the symptoms above. **The parent/guardian will be notified by phone and will have one hour from the time the phone call was made to pick-up their child.**

If a camper is identified as a **close contact** of a COVID-19 positive individual and they are not vaccinated, they must quarantine for:

- 7 days if the individual gets a negative test result on or after day 5, experiences **NO** symptoms, and continues to monitor for symptoms through day 14.
- 10 days if the individual experiences **NO** symptoms and continues to monitor for symptoms through day 14.
- 14 days if the individual experiences **ANY** symptoms during the 14 days.

CLEANING, DISINFECTING, SANITIZING

Bathrooms and common high-touch areas/surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected regularly. The barn will be cleaned and disinfected at the end of each day. Staff will disinfect all shared equipment after each use.

SUNSCREEN

Please, NO SHARING of sunscreen. Please send your camper with plenty of sunscreen. Please apply sunscreen to your child before they arrive in the morning.

****Only spray sunscreen is permitted – Staff will not be permitted to apply sunscreen to campers except to assist with spray.****

BUG & TICK REPELLENT

Spray repellent only. Please, NO SHARING of bug spray or tick repellent. Staff will only administer if a camper has their own repellent. Please be sure to do a thorough tick check when you get home from camp.
